ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Nordic combined COC Wisła 2013 Organizing Committee takes care of the full board accommodation for the athletes and officials.

The bookings for national teams are organized by the OC according to the team quotas and sent entries.

All the bookings and accommodation request shall be sent <u>directly to the LOC of Wisła</u> address.

The price for the daily full board accommodation, for those over national quotas, is:

- 45 Euro per person FB (GEOVITA hotel)
- 40 Euro per person FB (START hotel)

Cash and credit cards are accepted.

If there are any NSF who had made their own accommodation arrangements, these are obliged to inform the LOC about the fact not later than December, 24th

The LOC does not guarantee the availability of accommodation for requests and entries sent later than December. 31st

However, if there are vacant rooms left at the OC's disposal these will be provided to teams on request.
