ACCOMMODATION

The FIS Ski Jumping Continental Cup Wisła 2012 Organizing Committee takes care of the full board accommodation for the athletes and officials.

The bookings for national teams are organized by the OC according to the team quotas and sent entries.

All the bookings and accommodation request shall be sent <u>directly to the LOC of Wisła</u> <u>address.</u>

The official COC hotel is START (Olimpijska 1) and GEOVITA (os. Bajcary 14) in Wisła.

The price for the daily full board accommodation, for those over national quotas, is:


- 40 Euro per person FB (Geovita)
- 35 Euro per person FB (Start)

Cash and credit cards are accepted.

If there are any NSF who had made their own accommodation arrangements are obliged to inform the LOC about the fact not later than February, 15th

However, if there are vacant rooms left at the OC's disposal these will be provided to teams on request.
